

# Ring Theatre

## Pertinent Information

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**Seating** - 109 seats with 4 possible accessible seating locations

**Overall Stage Dimensions** - The stage is in a thrust configuration with the main stage area measuring roughly 24' wide x 24' (7.3m x 7.3m) deep up to the proscenium area.

**Stage Entrances** - There are 4 main entrances/exits to the stage at each corner with additional doors on either side of the proscenium.

**Backstage Areas** - There are two tight backstage areas directly upstage of either side of the proscenium, between 65 and 75 ft.<sup>2</sup> (6-7m<sup>2</sup>) each and the area upstage of the proscenium which is approximately 112 ft.<sup>2</sup> (10.4m<sup>2</sup>). The seating pods mask crossover passageways for performers and permit minimal props storage.

- There is one **trap** downstage, just stage left of center.
- The lighting grid is very high from the stage floor (approximately 28' or 8.5m) and is in full view of the audience.
- There is no fly system, though small objects such as chandeliers have been flown.
- The stage manager's control booth is located in an awkward position high near the grid in the USR corner of the stage. Visibility USR is limited.
